

## The Observed Calendar of the Second Temple Dates For 2009

The Observed Calendar of the Second Temple Era was used by the official priests of the Second Temple from at least 520 BC to 70 AD, which is about 30 generations. This is an astronomically based calendar using the visual new crescent moons and the equinoxes.

It is anticipated that the reader has read the full Calendar Presentation, minimally the files ENC202, CALNOSPO, BAB-530, and DATELINE. Without reading these documents the following information will probably not be fully appreciated.

### **2009 Calendar of Events: (dates are at NOON)**

March 28 (Sabbath)	-	New Year's Day (Nissan 1, Hillel says March 26)
April 10 (Friday Evening)	-	Passover (Hillel says 8 <sup>th</sup> )
April 11 (Sabbath)	-	First Holy Day Unleavened Bread (Hillel says 9 <sup>th</sup> )
to April 17 (Friday)	-	Second Holy Day for Days of Unleavened Bread
May 30 (Sunday)	-	Pentecost (from first Holy Day)
May 30 (Sunday)	-	Pentecost (from Saturday within)
September 21 (Monday)	-	Tishri 1 (Hillel says Sept. 19 <sup>th</sup> )
September 30 (Wednesday)	-	Day of Atonement (Hillel says 28 <sup>th</sup> )
October 5 (Monday)	-	Feast of Tabernacles (Hillel says 3 <sup>th</sup> )
to October 12 (Monday)	-	The Eighth Day (Hillel says 10 <sup>th</sup> )
